The Octagon Choir

The Octagon Choir was formed in 2010 and brings together people of all ages and abilities who love to sing. The Octagon Choir is led by our very own, Theatre Manager, Adam Burgan, and is a community of 80 members who rehearse weekly at Westlands Entertainment Venue. The Octagon Choir perform regularly and enjoy taking part in local celebrations including Yeovil Celebrates, SHiNE, and various community events in Yeovil and the surrounding areas. The choir is always welcoming and supportive of new members.

Somerset Youth Dance: Tinys

Aimed at ages 4-7, SYD Tinys is a dance class where young movers come together each week to move, create and have fun! Dancers enjoy learning new steps, exploring different styles and shapes and using their imagination. A friendly & supportive group where everyone grows in confidence and makes new friends.

Yeovil Dancentre

Starlets team are the current under 12 National Champions, competing and training with the Yeovil Dancentre. They are excited to be performing their new freestyle jazz routine themed on Red Descendants. This is the first time this team have performed together at a Shine Show. Stardust team are the current under 16 National Champions in their first year in this category. They can't wait to perform their new Circus themed routine with a hidden surprise on their costumes. They have now been dancing together for 5 months and are excited to be doing their first on stage demonstration together since they were children, as well as travelling straight to a competition ready for the next day after the show!
