I'M NOT DEAD, I'M ONLY SLEEPING

I'm Not Dead, I'm Only Sleeping is a dance theatre production which explores the ways we choose to live and die, tackling the feelings and emotions that surround death and the longing we all feel to live more fully in the moment.

Audiences will follow the lives of four people as they face death (both literal and metaphorical) within their relationships. This tender, provocative new work is about love, devotion, loss, memory and resolution. It talks to the importance of connection at times of adversity and how we shouldn't wait for death to reignite our relationship with life.

This production uses movement, voice over, text and original score to help tell the story and create a more familiar narrative experience.

The Octagon Theatre has one of the largest stages in the region with an intimate auditorium that seats 622.

We aim to bring our patrons a high quality theatrical experience, programming a diverse range of productions including professional and amateur theatre, dance, opera, music, comedy and children's shows. Our priority is to provide access to the creative arts for all with a diverse programme to entertain, educate & inspire multiple generations.

Over the coming years, there are plans in place to develop The Octagon Theatre, which will see the theatre transformed into a flagship venue for the arts & entertainment in Somerset. Members of South Somerset District Council voted unanimously in favour of the redevelopment of the Octagon, with the project is set to cost in the region of £23 million, with £10 million having been awarded to the project by central Government.

Since 2003, our dance development programme has provided performance and participation opportunities that benefit artists, companies, practitioners, children and young people, students, teachers, audiences, and venues, collaborating with various partners alongside our other specialisms - Early Years, Music, Rural Touring & Theatre.

As the strategic lead for dance in Somerset, we are instrumental in helping shape, resource and sustain the local dance sector, offering artistic and business support to professional dance artists and companies, as well as providing opportunities for networking, training, and mentoring. Our participatory projects, festivals, workshops, and events provide a platform for dancers of all ages and abilities to be part of an evolving and ever-growing community.

CURRENT DANCE PROJECTS

SPRING FORWARD

Spring Forward is an annual dance festival offering unrivalled opportunities for Somerset and Southwest based dancers to perform on a professional stage, participate in workshops and watch world-class dance performances. The festival has been running for over 15 years and traditionally takes place throughout March and April, aiming to provide dancers of all ages and abilities the opportunity to engage as a dancer, participant, teacher, youth dance group leader, dance artist and audience member in one of the professional venues we work with. Since 2005 Spring Forward has provided over 7000 dancers the opportunity to perform on a professional stage as part of 35 spectacular dance platforms. Our next Spring Forward platform will take place in Spring 2022.



LITTLE BIG DANCE

Little Big Dance is a major three-year national initiative created by South East Dance in partnership with Take Art, DanceEast and Yorkshire Dance, with more than £371,000 investment from Paul Hamlyn Foundation and Arts Council England. The project supports choreographers and dancers to create captivating and diverse work for and with under-fives and their families, particularly those from marginalised backgrounds with little or no access to the arts. Throughout two 18-month cycles, eight commissioned works will be developed, with four scaled for production in regional venues. Little Big Dance will support eight dance artists to gain valuable skills by working in a variety of pre-school settings in areas of England with little or no access to the arts.

OUR TURN

Our Turn is a two-year arts intervention project using dance to provide creative daytime activities that support the health and well-being of adults living with memory loss or dementia. The project is funded by Somerset County Council and will support the delivery of regular weekly dance sessions led by specialist dance artists. The project will help support falls prevention, improve physical and mental health and wellbeing, reduce loneliness and isolation as well as provide carers with respite. We are looking for organisations who provide services supporting older people with memory loss and dementia to refer people to our programme.



RURAL TOURING DANCE INITIATIVE

The Rural Touring Dance Initiative (RTDI) was launched in 2015 with the aim of bringing exciting and innovative dance theatre and dance performance to rural locations, using the established rural touring schemes to help make this happen successfully. Take Art are one of the lead partners within the project, alongside leading dance institutions The Place, China Plate, and the National Rural Touring Forum (NRTF). This innovative project, funded by Arts Council England, is helping to increase the quality, quantity and diversity of dance promoted by Rural Touring schemes all over the country. So far, the scheme has worked with 40 companies, promoting 140 shows to just under 13,000 audience members. Each year, Take Art's rural touring promoters have been offered the opportunity to take part in RTDI and one of our long-established promoters has become a Dance Ambassador for the project. 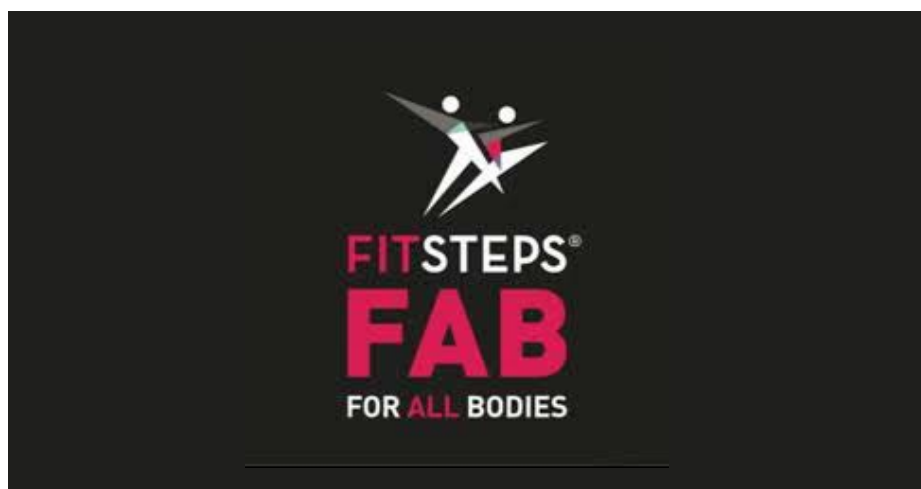
